Members Declaration:

I will respect and accept the rules and procedures set down in the Kilcock Canoe Polo Club Policies & Procedures Documents and the ICU Child Protection Policy.

- Being able to swim.
- Not canoe alone. Players should abide the guidelines of the Irish Canoe Union who recommend paddling in groups of three or more. Junior paddlers should paddle in groups of three or more with at least one senior paddler.
- Learn the rules of our sport and abide by them.
- Respect my opponents. Treat them, as I would like to be treated.
- Not use foul/ vulgar language.
- Behave in a manner that reflects the quality atmosphere and ethos of the club.
- Be responsible for my own gear and respect the Club's equipment.
- Wear a buoyancy aid at all times while canoeing.
- Wear a helmet with face guard at all times while playing canoe polo.
- Not use cameras, camera mobile phones and other visual recording devices in changing rooms/ areas.
- Respect the Club's equipment.
- Respect and accept the decision of the referees, coaches, leaders, and instructors.
- Not partake in alcoholic drink and other illegal/unlawful substances as these are prohibited at Club activities.
